KENYA TUITAKAYO... THE PEOPLE'S CHARTER

END IMPUNITY NOW!

We the Kenyan People;

COGNIZANT of our ethnic, cultural and religious diversity;

DESIROUS to live in peace and unity as one indivisible sovereign nation;

RECOGNIZING the grave political, economic and social challenges injustices facing our country including predatory public borrowing and taxation, wanton theft of public resources and rise in the cost of living;

AWARE that these challenges are occasioned by bad leadership and unaccountable governance;

EXERCISING our sovereign and inalienable right to action to reassert that power vests on the people and save our country from potential implosion;

HEREBY ADOPT AND DECLARE this People's Charter and **CALL ON ALL KENYANS** to arise, unite and organize in order to claim and secure;

1. DIGNITY AND HUMAN RIGHTS FOR ALL:

All Kenyans are created with inalienable rights. Every Kenyan deserves a life of dignity. Every Kenyan has a right to basic needs of food, healthcare, security, freedom and education. The violation of such rights and/or dignity by state, security forces, foreigners, businesses or individuals shall bear severe punishment on the perpetrator including retribution, restitution and deterrence in every way possible.

2. SOVEREIGNTY AND PUBLIC RESOURCES:

The Kenyan state and public finance are under capture by a small but powerful group of individuals, who have directed public planning and development towards their own primitive greed and accumulation to the detriment of everyone else. This must change NOW! All individuals and groups guilty of capture of public institutions for personal wealth or power MUST be prosecuted. ALL public finance management, and political institutions MUST exclude all who are guilty of theft of public resources, and all proceeds of stolen public resources MUST be recovered. ALL public resources belong to the people of Kenya and MUST be utilized in an open and accountable way at every administrative unit and level.

3. INCLUSIVE AND JUST NATION:

Various regimes have discriminated against its own citizens in public employment, public procurement, service delivery, development and security services. This MUST stop. All people in Kenya will have equitable say and direction in the security, social, political, economic and development makeup of the nation regardless of their ethnicity, gender, age, abilities and conditions. Every Kenyan deserves an equal chance in life. Those who have been historically marginalized and discriminated deserve equity and justice and everyone has a right to prosperity and fulfillment.

4. POWER AND SOVEREIGNTY:

Kenyans are tired of pre-determined, expensive and meaningless elections. Either our vote counts or there should be no more pretenses of elections! The powers and legitimacy of EVERY elective office shall be obtained only through just, free, fair and credible election. No more manipulation, intimidation and subversion of the people' will. Constitutionally guaranteed affirmative action MUST be implemented faithfully to ensure fair representation of ALL Kenyans.

5. YOUTH AND DEVELOPMENT:

Kenya's youth form the majority of the population but are excluded in democratic and developmental processes leading to high unemployment, poverty, insecurity and disenfranchisement, disillusionment and exploitation. Youth development must be at the centre of all development processes. Youth have a right to affirmative action in employment, politics, economics, training, opportunities, resources and skills for inclusive and sustainable development.

6. QUALITY AND RELEVANT EDUCATION FOR ALL:

Kenya's education system is arbitrarily changed, increasingly uncompetitive globally, unresponsive to individual and national needs locally, and highly corrupted. All Kenyans deserve education that responds to the needs of the individual, community, nation and continent that is competitive in the global geo-political and economic arena. ALL Kenyans MUST have equal access to quality, free and compulsory education for all.

7. BASIC SERVICES FOR ALL:

Many Kenyans are vulnerable and deprived of safe water, food, healthcare and shelter due to theft and misuse of public resources that could provide them these basic needs. All Kenyans MUST have access to basic rights and services including quality public health, water, food, transport, energy and shelter for all. No government deserves power if it cannot provide these basic services.

8. PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY FOR ALL:

Security forces in Kenya have been used to suppress dissent, extort and subvert the democratic will of citizens rather than to protect the people and the constitution. All Kenyans MUST be guaranteed safety and security in all regions, residential locations and legitimate economic activities. Arbitrary arrests, detentions, harassment, forced disappearances and extra-judicial killings MUST stop. Individuals, commanders and institutions guilty of violating the rights of the individual MUST be held individually and collectively accountable for such violation no matter how long it takes.

9. SOVEREIGNTY OVER OUR LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES:

Kenya's public lands, forests, minerals and waters have been illegally allocated to private interests to the detriment of the public. We will repossess and protect all public land and resources. We will aggressively implement actions that optimize and protect community lands and natural resources for the benefit of current and future generations.

10. EQUALITY BEFORE THE LAW:

Segregation of the people on the basis of economic class and political power is unacceptable. All Kenyans will be equal before the law. We MUST implement the constitution fully and faithfully. ALL Kenyans MUST have unfettered access to public information in order to protect the constitution. We will protect sovereign institutions from systematic weakening by criminals and opportunists within and outside of the state.

In proclaiming this Charter, we the people of Kenya pledge to invest all our energy to ensure that our country, our government and all its institutions and our elected and appointed officials work for the people in accordance with our Constitution. We further pledge, for the sake of present and future generations, to use all lawful means to take our country back from the small cabal of corrupt individuals that currently holds us hostage.
